Intended use:

The Advanced Inflation Device is used with balloon dilation catheter to monitor inflation pressure.

Contraindications:

Those specific to procedures to be performed in conjunction with balloon dilation.

Complications:

Possible complications include, but are not limited to the following:

- Vessel wall perforation
- Infection
- Bleeding
- Edema
- Tissue trauma

Caution:

Federal (USA) law restricts this device to sale by or on the order of a physician.

Warning/ Precaution:

- Always follow the manufacturer's directions accompanying the balloon dilation catheter for instruction for use, maximum inflation pressure, precautions and warnings for that device.
- For Single Use Only
- To be used by experienced surgeons
- Dispose in accordance with recognized medical practice and under observance of applicable law and regulation.
- Store in a cool & dry place.

Instruction for Use:

- 1. Prepare a solution of contrast medium and normal saline in a small sterile bowl. Check balloon catheter instructions for specificcontrast mixture recommendations.
- Attach the tubing to the head of the pressure gauge with piston fully depressed.
- Pulling the syringe plunger with tubing dipped in contrast solution, aspirate enough to fill the syringe.
- 4. Hold the device upright to purge the air from the syringe and connecting tube. Tap the syringe slightly, to remove all the air bubbles, and fill the connecting tube completely.
- Inspect the syringe, tubing and stopcock to ensure that the device is completely purged.

- Attach the Inflation device to the balloon dilatation catheter as manufacturer's direction of use.
- 7. To inflate the balloon catheter, advance the plunger till possible and then lock the barrel flange. For increasing the pressure, twist the knob slowly till desired inflation pressure is reached.
- To deflate the balloon, first turn the knob anticlockwise till the pressure is released completely, and then retract the plunger to deflate the balloon completely.
